Tips for Drivers:

Stop for pedestrians at crosswalks. It's the law!

SERT TODAL

- See Flashing Yellow = Slow Down & Prepare to STOP
- STOP! Look both left and right before turning right at traffic signals and stop signs.
- · Share the road with bicyclists. Allow at least 3 Feet when passing.
- · Always watch for pedestrians and bicyclists, especially at night!
- Leave a little earlier and don't speed. Getting fined or being involved in a crash can wreck your day!
